TYPE: white dry wine.

VARIETY: 100% Vermentino.
PRODUCTION AREA: Gallura.

MUNICIPALITY: Telti - Calangianus (Olbia).

AVARAGE AGE OF THE PLANTS: 15 years.

PLANT DENSITY: 5500 plants/hectares.

YIELD PER HECTAR: 80 quintals.

YIELD PER PLANT: 1,5 kg.

SPACING OF THE VINES: 2,40 m. x 0.80 m. **ALTITUDE:** from 325 m. a.s.l. to 400 m. a.s.l.

 $\textbf{EXPOSURE:} \ South-East.$

TRAINING SYSTEM: simple Guyot.

TYPE OF SOIL: sandy loam of granitic to clayey/sandy origin with a strong presence of quartz stones consisting of minerals such as quartz, on a base matrix ranging from a fine-grained to a glassy structure.

HARVEST TIME: first decade of September.

VINIFICATION:

Manual harvesting in small boxes.

De-stemming and soft pressing in low temperature.

Clarification: static cold.

<u>Fermentation:</u> in steel tanks 16/18 °C. <u>Duration of fermentation:</u> 15 days. <u>Malolactic fermentation:</u> none.

 $\underline{\textbf{Elevage:}} \ \textbf{6} \ \textbf{months on the lees}.$

Filtration: natural.

Ageing in bottle: 2 months. Production: 48.000 bottles.

Alcohol: 14% in vol. Acidity: 6 g/l. pH: 3,30
