



MONTEPULCIANO D´ABRUZZO “CASTELLO DI SEMIVICOLI”

In 2009, after a long conservative restoration, the Semivicoli Castle was opened to the public to become the great "wine house" of Masciarelli.

Today Masciarelli produces 22 labels and distributes wines from the most interesting oenological territories in Europe: from Portugal to Burgundy, from Champagne to Moselle, Tokaj, France-short, all for tasting at the Semivicoli Castle.

From the desire to make a blend of Bordeaux in a local key, was born one of the most original labels of the house of Masciarelli. It is a refined blend of Montepulciano, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, made from three high-density guyot vines, from which 80 quintals of grapes are harvested. Its aromatic depth ranges from notes of raspberry, plum and orange peel to spice. The body is full, round and structured with juicy tannins that give it tension; the finish is savory and fruity.
