-Grape: 50% **syrah**, 25% **merlot**, 25% **cabernet** sauvignon

-Denomination: Langhe Rosso doc

-Vineyard of origin: Located in Farigliano village (on South of Barolo area)

- 0,8 ha
- 25 years old plants
- South exposure
- Altitude from 440 to 500 m
- Calcareous clay soil

-Production: 4.000 bottles

-Aging: after the alcoholic fermentation in steel, 18 months in very old oak barriques.

-Gillardi style: we have tried to give a **local identity** to this **international grapes**. Together they form a unique blend in its category: traditional and modern at the same time.

- Characteristics: Intense purple red.

A rich, round and expressive wine, soft and structured, velvety and pleasant tannins, on the finish the residual sugar remains and releases fullness and fleshiness.
